We are so excited that you are interested in learning more about Winter Guard! Here are some questions & answers on who we are and what this program is all about.

What is Winter Guard?

Winter Guard is a performance art that uses dance, theater while spinning/tossing equipment such as flags, rifles, and sabres to give a visual interpretation to music.

We are members of the Pacific Performing Arts (PPA) competitive circuit and attend competitions. Although we have competitive goal, we are still open to introducing the activity to new students wanting learn and perform with us.

How hard is Winter Guard?

Like any other sport, you will need to build endurance, muscle strength as well as increase your mental sharpness and focus. But we don't demand that on the first day. We will teach you these skills starting with basics and progress as we go.

If you have a mental or physical issue that could impede your ability to learn or limits your abilities, make sure it is on file with your school and then include it on your Audition Agreement (attached). If medications are needed, please understand that the staff cannot be responsible for holding or applying this medication. We will provide assistance when needed, but the student must carry it with them in case of emergency need.

Any Experience needed?

No experience needed. We have instructors and current members to help you learn what you need to know.

It is important that you show up willing, eager, and open to every aspect of the audition process. It is highly likely that we will ask you to do some things that we do that you have never done before. We recognize that you will likely be stronger in some areas than others. And that's ok. Just come ready to learn, give it a try and have fun.

Are there any fees to join?

No. Winter Guard is free to join. All equipment is provided. Some personal items, such as gloves, shoes, team t-shirt, etc., will need to be purchased by the student for their own use. Estimated cost: \$80+/-. Fundraisers may to take place to help with overall activity/club needs and/or students who may need assistance with purchases.

What if I am involved in another after school activity that practices at the same time?

You will have to ask your other sponsor/coach if it's possible to do both. Schedules may conflict resulting in your choosing one or the other. If you do another activity alongside guard, you'll have to balance the time between the two activities. For Winter Guard, you are responsible for catching up, learning and memorizing anything you have missed; which will be done on your own time.

I'm interested, what do I do next?

Fill out the required forms and come to Winter Guard Camp. The Audition Agreement must be signed by you and your parent/legal guardian. You will NOT be allowed to participate if forms are not received.

Camp is 4 days long. You will learn different skills each day along with a short audition routine. Although not required, we high suggest you come for all 4 days so that you learn as much as possible giving you the full experience so you can best make your decision on wanting to continue.

- Nov 27: Audition day! 1:30-3pm in the band room
- Results given on Nov 28th (first team meeting)

If I make the team, when will the rehearsals be?

Rehearsals will start on Nov 28, 2024. After that, we will have rehearsals every Monday through Friday in the Band Room or off campus (excluding holidays and other district no-school days). A schedule will be given to you at the first meeting.
